Pam, Julie and Marge attended regional workshop mostly on new voting registration forms and redistricting. All found it helpful.

Fire District Info: Still no word on mediation judgment. Washington Township has proposed have four paid firemen positions. They want to assess Washington residents approximately \$50 per \$100,000 property value. Town has not decided whether to join. Ruth believes there are rules for a remonstrance on this local issue.
